

Fields

Phase 1 will include four baseball fields to make the park "tournament quality". High level tournaments will be attracted to the park, making a positive economic impact in the community. With favorable bids, we are hoping to construct two full size soccer fields with lighting on one. This will enable the Parks and Recreation Department to move the youth soccer program from the SECEP facility (Southeastern Cooperative Education Program) to the Deep Creek Park.

Lighting

The sports fields and parking lots with lights are located at the center of the 230-acre park site. This location creates a large buffer between these facilities and residences.

Access Paths

The Dismal Swamp Canal Trail is an important recreational amenity in the Deep Creek community. Signage will be placed at the park entrance guiding visitors to the Canal Trail.

Plans call for the developer of Culpepper Landing to construct a swing bridge to accommodate foot and bicycle traffic to the Deep Creek Park. The developer estimates the bridge will be completed in approximately three years.
